WHAT TO EXPECT:

TNT's goals are to enhance not only stage skills but also the cooperation, creativity and goal-setting that every theatrical production requires.

- Campers will audition, rehearse, study lines, make props/sets/costumes (according to their age ability), do crafts, and play games.
- Campers will probably come home tuckered out, paint splattered, and with several new friends. They may need help studying their lines or items from their closet for their onstage costume. We try not to incur any unnecessary expenses for our campers.
- Campers may not be dropped off earlier than 15 minutes before the start of their TNT session and must be picked up within 15 minutes of the end of their TNT session. A **\$10** fee per occurrence will be assessed if this policy is violated.

WHAT TO BRING

- Each camper needs to **bring a snack & beverage** for the daily break. Morning campers may want to bring a lunch since the camp runs until 1:00pm.
- **Clothes** should be "work clothes" that allow movement & can get dirty (creating is messy business). Please wear an official TNT camp t-shirt as often as possible.
- Shoes must have closed toes (NO sandals or flipflops) that allow running/jumping.

What You need to know about TNT 2024 Daytime Camps

- Please keep all purses, backpacks, cellphones, personal electronics, and other non-essential items at home. CCT has an office phone if calls need to be made.
- If a troupe will be wearing stage make-up, each camper is responsible for providing his/her own mascara and/or eyeliner for health reasons. Parents will be notified of this need by the first day of TNT.

ATTENDANCE

Each TNT troupe will produce their own one act play at the **Grand Finale Showcases on Saturday**, **June 29**th so Campers **MUST** be able to **attend every weekday and Saturday the 29**th. Because of the time constraints regarding rehearsals for the showcase performances, TNT reserves the right not to accept registrations from those who have conflicts that will prevent daily attendance at Camp and/or at their Showcase performances.

GRAND FINALE SHOWCASE

Family & friends are all welcome to attend any & all of the Showcases. "Admission" is non-perishable foods or personal toiletry items which are donated to the Good Samaritan. Performance times and ability to video record the presentations will be confirmed by the first day of TNT 2024 as will the Showcase times schedule.

REGISTRATION

- All TNT registrations are first-come, first-served and space is limited.
- Online and telephone registrations are not possible.
- Campers registered by May 25th will receive a free official TNT t-shirt.
- To register, please submit an information packet with all completed forms and the appropriate fee by cash, check, money order or credit card. A notarized medical release/health form is required.
- Registration forms must be fully completed and all fees paid for a camper to be considered registered so only completed packets will be processed and registered.
- Registration packets can be sent to CCT at **PO Box 377**, **Rusk Texas 75785** or delivered to the Theater Box Office at **157 West 5**th **Street in Rusk**.
- Campers will be contacted by telephone or e-mail to confirm enrollment. Please contact TNT as soon as possible to cancel a registration. Fees are non-refundable after **May 25, 2024.**
