TNT PM will run from July 17 – 28 (Monday through Friday) from 5:30 until 9:30 pm

Designed for teens entering Grade 9 through exiting Grade 12. Prior theatre experience is not necessary; just a willingness to learn and have fun. TNT PM has a repertory format with all TNT PMers enrolling in the program rather than specific troupes. Each TNT PMer will submit a personal "Skills Inventory" theatre arts experiences and goals. This will help us offer applicable opportunities for learning and/or improving. Theatre skills games, set/prop/costume construction and rehearsals make up the daily program. When possible, special guest artists provide workshops during the first week.

Onstage Track: The first night of TNT PM, those TNTers wanting to focus on onstage skills will participate in a professional-styled audition with a casting panel. The audition process will focus on cold readings and physical activities so a prepared monologue will not be needed. TNTers will audition for their show to be performed for family & friends at the Grand Finale Showcase on July 29rd.

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Offstage Track: Designed for teens more interested in acquiring technical skills by serving as stage managers & asst. tech directors. Students will help the troupe directors create and implement technical aspects and then “run the show” that will be used in the Showcases. Please contact TNT @ CCT for more information on this year’s tech program.

8th Grade Participants: TNT PM will accept a limited number of “moving up” applications from students entering 8th grade who have extensive theatrical experience. Please submit the Moving Up application materials along with the registration forms.

WHAT TO BRING/ WHAT TO EXPECT:

- TNT PMers are asked to provide a daily snack & beverage.
- Clothing should be comfortable & modest items that can get dirty & paint-splattered because creating art is messy. Closed-toe shoes such as sneakers **must** be worn for safety because CCT is a working theater. Sandals/flipflops are NOT allowed. Participants not dressed for TNT PM needs will be asked to go home and change.
- TNT PMers may need items from their closet for their onstage costume. We try not to incur any unnecessary expenses for our TNT PMers. For health reasons, each TNT PMer must provide his/her own mascara and eyeliner.
- Personal electronics use is not allowed during TNT PM, so students bringing such items with them will be asked to put them aside in a specific, safe location. Also, please do not bring any personal valuables or large amounts of money to TNT PM.
- TNT PMers may not be dropped off earlier than 15 minutes before the start of their TNT session and must be picked up within 15 minutes of the end of their TNT session. A **\$10 fee per occurrence** will be assessed if this policy is violated.
- Because of the time constraints regarding rehearsals for the showcase performances, TNT reserves the right not to accept registrations from those who have conflicts that will prevent daily attendance at TNT PM or at the Showcase performances.

ATTENDANCE

TNT PMers will produce their own one act play at the **Grand Finale Showcases on Saturday, July 29th** so PMers **MUST** be able to attend **every weekday evening and Saturday the 29th**. Because of the time constraints regarding rehearsals for the showcase performances, TNT reserves the right not to accept registrations from those who have conflicts that will prevent daily attendance at Camp or at the Showcase performances.

Family & friends are all welcome to attend any & all of the Showcases. “Admission” is non-perishable foods or personal toiletry items which are donated to the Good Samaritan. Performance times and ability to video record the presentations will be confirmed by the first day of TNT 2017.

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REGISTRATION

- All TNT registrations are first-come, first-served and space is limited. Phone registrations are not possible. Campers registered by June 21st will receive a free official TNT t-shirt.
- To register, please submit an information packet with all forms and the appropriate fee by cash, check, money order or credit card. A notarized medical release/health form is required.
Registration forms must be fully completed and all fees paid for a camper to be considered registered so completed packets will be registered before incomplete ones.
- Registration packets can be sent to CCT at **PO Box 377, Rusk Texas 75785** or delivered to the Theater Box Office at **157 West 5th Street in Rusk**. Sorry, originals are required so we're not able to accept registrations or payments by email.
- Campers will be contacted by phone or e-mail to confirm enrollment. Please contact TNT as soon as possible to cancel a registration. Fees are non-refundable after **June 21, 2017**.

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CAMPER PARTICIPATION PLEDGE : Grades 9-12

At TNT, we want every participant to have an enjoyable learning experience so here are a few guidelines to which both parents and campers need to agree. Parents, please read this over **with** your camper and discuss what it means so everyone understands. Failure to follow these guidelines can lead to immediate dismissal from TNT Camp.

As a Thespian 'N Training, I PLEDGE to:

1. Respect the fact that everyone brings different experiences and ideas to the theatre and this is what makes it such an exciting art form. Therefore, I will respect the opinions of my campers and keep unnecessary negativity to myself.
2. Recognize that being supportive of the entire theatrical team and the show in production is more important than being "a star". This also means I will accept whatever role I'm assigned and give it all my best.
3. Understand that *all* aspects of theatre – onstage, backstage, and offstage – are important to the success of both the TNT camp and the Showcase performances, so I shall participate willingly in all camp activities.
4. Follow the rules, guidelines and decisions of the TNT program and the TNT Staff during TNT camp.
5. Take care of the buildings and equipment of Cherokee Civic Theatre because it belongs to our entire community theatre family, not just TNT Campers.
6. Follow all safety guidelines regarding tools and construction and to not use any tool without an adult training and/or supervising me.
7. Recognize that, for my safety and well-being, areas of the Cherokee Civic Theatre building will be deemed off-limits without TNT Staff supervision, so I will stay where I'm allowed to go and have a buddy at all times.
8. Leave items that belong to other campers or CCT alone unless given permission to use them. This includes, but is not limited to: costumes, props, equipment, personal property, money, food and beverages.
9. Participate in the TNT activities without creating disturbances or disruptions that prevent any other TNT Campers from learning or from enjoying their time at TNT – in particular, PDA (public displays of affection) and IPE (intrusive personal electronics). To this end, I shall keep my body to myself and keep my toys (including but not limited to video/music players, hand-held games, cell phones) at home or in the CCT Office during camp hours.
10. Acknowledge that disrespect for this pledge and/or any person, property or productions connected with TNT and CCT will result in my being dismissed from TNT camp to make space for a person who really wants to participate.
11. Understand that every day of TNT Camp is important to my cast mates & our show so I must attend every day of TNT Camp including the Grand Finale Showcase. If I am absent, TNT Camp has the right to remove me from the program, so I need to plan doctor appointments, other camp programs and vacations so that they do not conflict with TNT Camp.
