

TNT 2017 Scholarships

AWARDS:

Grades 1-8: 1 full scholarship per troupe (4 total)

Grades 9-12: 4 full “work” scholarships with recipients serving as Jr. Counselors for daytime TNT troupes. In addition to working daily with their assigned daytime troupe, Teen recipients **must** attend a pre-camp counselor training (date TBA), participate in the pre-camp set-up, post-camp clean-up and serve as technicians during the day of Grand Finale Showcases (July 29).

APPLICATIONS

Grades 1-4

Student: Create an artwork (drawing, collage, etc.) that’s no larger than 8.5”x11” to show us what you like most about plays, acting and/or pretending.

Parents: Please submit **typed** responses (1.0-1.5 pages) to these two questions:

1. What skills/interests would your child bring with him/her to TNT Camp?
2. From what would your child benefit most at TNT Camp?

Grades 5-8

Student: Write an essay (1.5-2.5 pages typed or legibly handwritten) answering these three questions:

1. What you like most about theatre arts and why
2. How and why would TNT 2017 help you?

Parents: Please submit **typed** responses (1.0-1.5 pages) to these two questions:

1. What skills/interests would your child bring with him/her to TNT Camp?
2. From what would your child benefit most at TNT Camp?

Grades 9-12

Student: Complete a Jr. Counselor Application and write an essay (2 pages typed) answering these three questions:

1. How and why has theatre impacted your life?
2. How and why would TNT 2017 help you?
3. How could you be an asset to the TNT daytime troupes?

Parents: Please submit **typed** responses (1.0-1.5 pages) to these two questions:

1. What skills/interests would your child bring with him/her to TNT Camp?
2. From what would your child benefit most at TNT Camp?

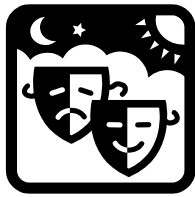
SUBMISSION:
